Loads contaminated with these items can't be made into new goods and must be sent to the landfill to prevent jamming the recycling machines. What a waste! However, you can take these items elsewhere to be disposed of / recycled. Here are some options:

- Plastic bags- take to Walmart or Dillons
- Motor oil containers- Walmart, O'Reilly Auto Parts, Sedgwick County 316-660-7458
- Tree limbs- Bel Aire's seasonal Brush Site, 744-2451; Sedgwick County, 660-7200
- Yard Waste- Call Sedgwick Co 660-7200 for complete list
- Electronics-Bel Aire's spring E-Recycle Day, 744-2451; Sedgwick County, 660-7200
- Hazardous waste- Sedgwick County Household Hazardous Waste Facility, 660-7458
- Shredded paper, Light bulbs, Mirrors, Window glass, Ceramics, Dishes- call 660-7200
