Winter Average Consumption

Sewer rates are calculated every year based on your average winter water usage, known as Winter Average Consumption (WAC). Usage during December, January, and February, which is billed the following month (January, February, and March), will be used for this calculation. This WAC will be used from April to March of the following year when WAC is recalculated.

Any water leak repairs made during this time should be reported to the Utility Department.

$$WAC = \frac{DEC + JAN + FEB}{3}$$

IMPORTANT REQUEST FROM YOUR WATER SUPPLIER

Dear City of Bel Aire Water Customer,

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) recently announced changes to drinking water regulations which require water suppliers to identify all materials used in the construction of the water system. These changes aim to identify and remove all lead pipes and lead materials used in the drinking water system. The water suppliers are requested to identify ALL construction materials used in both the supplier's AND customer's side of the water meter (including private in-home plumbing materials).

The City of Bel Aire needs your help to meet this requirement. Please complete the attached survey as soon as possible.
