

Drought Response Efforts

Bel Aire receives water from the City of Wichita and the Chisholm Creek Utility Authority, and is governed by water restrictions imposed by these suppliers. Wichita has been implementing drought response efforts since January 2023 and water levels at Cheney Reservoir are continuing to decrease.

The City of Wichita recently entered into Stage 2 drought response, which limits irrigating to one day per week. Bel Aire will also be required to limit watering during this time.

Lead Service Line Inventory (LSLI) Survey

Government regulations are requiring identification of materials used in water systems to help identify and remove pipes containing lead and copper from drinking water systems. While these contaminants are not present in our source water, they can potentially enter tap water through the corrosion of service line piping and older household plumbing materials. In compliance with drinking water regulations, we are requesting that customers complete a survey to help our inventory of Bel Aire service lines. Thank you for your cooperation – together we can ensure that we continue to provide clean and safe drinking water to Bel Aire customers.

If you have already completed a waterline survey, you may disregard this request.
